***Office of College & Career Readiness (OCCR) Summer Bridge Programs***

**Summer Bridge** – The Princeton Review will offer two programs within a two-week transition program structure for rising 9<sup>th</sup> graders: Early Edge 101 and UP Next. Early Edge is an early college preparation course that reinforces and increases the basic foundational skills students need to perform at grade level. The UP Next program is a modular, workshop-based program designed to improve student retention, and graduation rates by developing non- academic skills such as goal setting, leadership, time management, and community building.
