SUMMER PROGRAMS

For children who will start Kindergarten this fall, this program will prepare and increase the confidence of rising kindergarteners and their families. Kindergarten enrollees will receive an email invitation directly.

For children who will begin 1st through 7th grade this fall, this program offers academic enrichment and extracurricular activities for a full day camp experience. English learners at level 2.0 and above may apply.

This invite-only program is for English Learners entering grades 1-7 and entering grades 8-11. English Learners who a) enrolled after January 1st 2022 and b) have a current English Proficiency Level of 1.0-1.5, will be invited.

Free services for students who require special education support and services beyond the regular 180-day school year. Student participation is determined by the IEP team, parent/guardian registration is not required.

For children who will begin 8th and 9th grade this fall and would like to gain real world, practical experience while learning how to start a business. Students may also obtain credentials for high school graduation.

For high school students who have failed a previous course, this program provides an opportunity to earn the grades and credits needed for graduation.

Students entering grades 10-12 will gain an entrepreneurial mindset in this four week program. They will gain the skills needed to start a business by learning the integral skills needed when becoming an entrepreneur.

Students entering grades 6-12 will learn the fundamentals of drumline percussion and perform in an ensemble, along with supplemental music instruction. Summer Drumline is an extension of our Spring regional drumline program.
