

**School District of Philadelphia Fall 2020 Admissions Guidelines for Schools With Admissions Criteria**

1. Admission decisions are made based on each school’s published entrance criteria.
2. The School District of Philadelphia shall deny the admission of a nonresident student to any school or academic program where such enrollment would displace a resident student or require the district to incur additional costs.
3. The unique qualifications of an applicant may be considered to ensure school communities whose members have diverse backgrounds and life experiences. Every effort is made to enhance equity and school diversity.
4. Due to space limitations, not all qualified applicants may be offered admission.
5. Illegal suspensions will not be considered when evaluating applicants.
