













How to translate a Chrome Webpage into another language:

Step 1: Add the Chrome Extension Google Translate to your browser (only have to do this once)

Do this	What does it look like
On your chromebook click on the white circle located in the bottom left of your screen.	
Locate the Web Store icon	
Search for Google Translate	
Click on Add to Chrome	
Click Add Extension	
The Google Translate icon will now be in your browser bar (top right of screen)	

Step 2: Select the language that you will be translating a website into for reading

Do this	What does it look like
<p>Navigate to translate.google.com in your address bar</p>	
<p>Type any word in the left panel and select the language you want to translate into in the right panel. Use the arrow to see a dropdown menu of available languages</p>	
<p>* Navigate to the website you want to use and once the page loads click on the Google Translate extension icon in the upper right hand side of your address bar. Click twice on TRANSLATE THIS PAGE</p>	
<p>* Above the website and below the address bar you will see The Google Translated to menu appear. Using the drop down menu, select the language you want. The website will now be translated into the selected language.</p> <p>You can click on Show Original if you want to return to the English version.</p>	
<p>Note: * steps will need to be completed each time you want to translate a web page.</p>
