COMMUNICATION ABOUT STUDENT LEARNING:

Barton School is committed to frequent two-way communication with families about children's learning. Some of the ways you can expect us to reach you are:

-Barton will hold a back to school night in the beginning of September where parents can come visit their child's classroom as well as meet the principal and staff and go over school rules and expectations.

-Weekly FYI newsletters to parents will be sent home every Monday in the student's Homework Folder.

-Monthly parent workshops will be held on the second Wednesday of each month by Maria Louvaris (SBTL) to teach parents different strategies in working with their child in Reading and Math.

-Parent/Teacher report card conferences will be held three times during the year in November, February and April to discuss student's progress.

-Parent Portal is available through the district's website. Nancy Torres (SISL) can assist parents in accessing their child's progress.

-Teachers use the Remind App to communicate with parents.

-Teachers will also contact parents through notes and phone calls when needed.
