Dear Colleagues,

While the Benefits Open Enrollment window runs through June 30, in order for changes to your medical enrollment to be effective on July 1, we must receive your application by midnight Sunday, May 31. Changes to your medical enrollment received during the month of June will be effective on August 1. All wage continuation cancellations will be processed effective July 1. Enrollments in wage continuation will be effective at the start of the new school year. Remember, Open Enrollment is your opportunity to make certain changes to your benefits like enrolling or cancelling Wage Continuation coverage, or adding or removing a dependent child or spouse.
