All newly enrolled students must submit the following:

**1. An Updated Physical Examination**

The student's healthcare provider must utilize one of the forms below when completing the Physical Examination:

[MEH 1](#): This standard physical exam form should be used if your student will not participate in athletics (sports teams) this year.

[PIAA Form](#): This physical exam form is more detailed and is required for participation in school athletics (sports teams).

**2. Vaccine records**

All students must be compliant with the Pennsylvania school-age vaccination law in order to attend school. [Click here](#) for additional information on immunization requirements.

**3. A Student Emergency/ Medical Information Form (S-865)**

This form must be completed for every student annually by a parent/ guardian to inform of any medical condition or medication use. This form also indicates permission for your student to receive acetaminophen or ibuprofen, if needed, during the school day. These medications will not be administered without written permission. The form can be printed for completion or accessed online:

For everyone's safety, students are not permitted to bring any medications into school

without written permission from the parent, healthcare provider, and the approval of the school nurse. This includes asthma inhalers and over the counter medications. If your student needs medication during the school day, a [Med 1-Medication Form \(PDF\)](#) must be completed by the student's physician and signed by the parent/ guardian. A separate form is required for each medication that needs to be taken in school.

Please reach out to the school nurse if your student has a medical condition requiring accommodations.

Please submit forms no later than Orientation Day.
