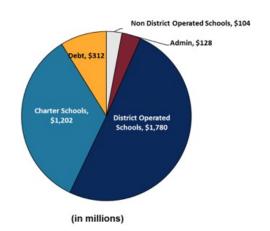

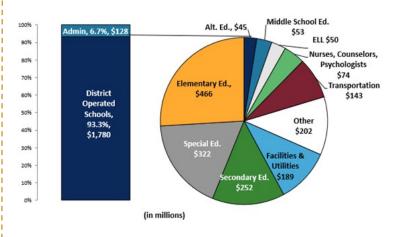

School Expenditures by Category (FY21 Adopted Budget)



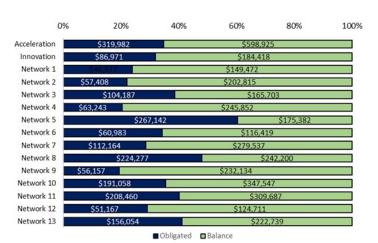

Part-Time Salary & Non-Personnel Obligated by Network



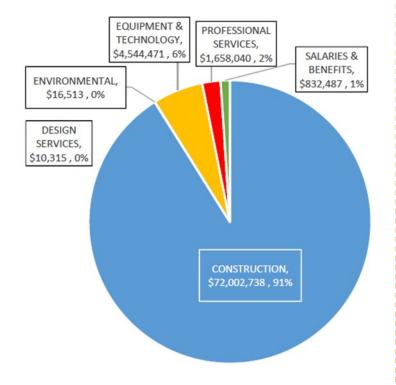
