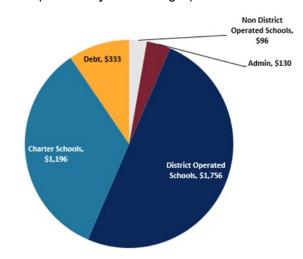

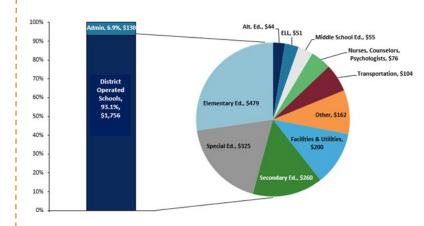

School Exp by Category (FY21 Projected Budget)



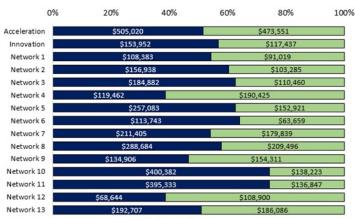

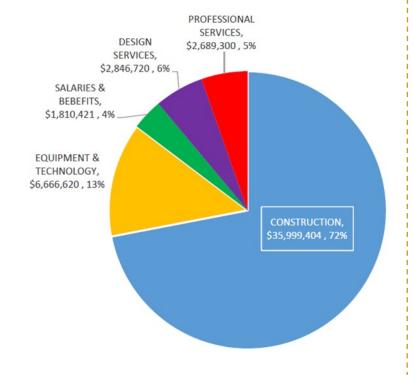
