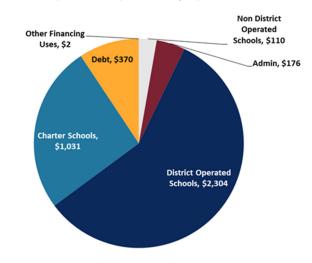

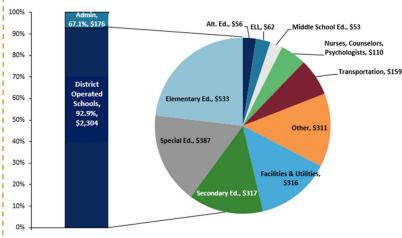

#### School Expenditures by Category (FY23 Adopted Budget)



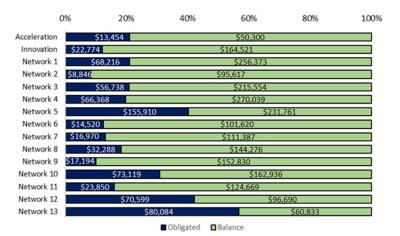

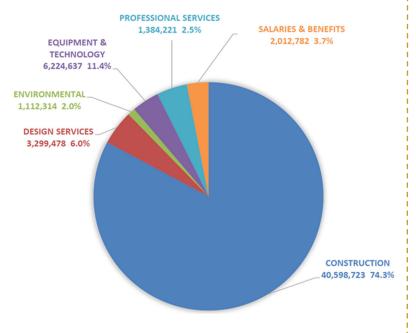
