Your child can receive the BinaxNOW COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test in a timely fashion at no cost to you. This test involves a quick and painless swab to the front of the nose. The swab, which is similar to a Q-tip is inserted a small distance of one half inch into both nostrils. Results are available in 15 minutes.
