I am writing to share information about an exciting investment happening in our school.

Our school will receive \$1,507,310 in upgrades to our chiller and air conditioning system. The upgrades will make our school more comfortable for students and staff, and more efficient as a teaching environment. We are replacing the old chiller and related components, making the rooms more comfortable and evenly cooled throughout the building.

This is an exciting and welcome safety upgrade for our school. The work will be carried out during the day by J. Mann-R. Finley, Inc., PT Mechanical Group, LLC and Hyde Electric Corporation. A Project Manager from the School District will be assigned to supervise the contractor to ensure minimal disruption to the school day.
