Our school will receive \$1,572,925 in site improvements that will help manage stormwater on our property, and in our community. This project includes the removal or updating of surfaces or drainage areas around the school. Replacement to our current materials will allow water to pass through them more efficiently.

This is an exciting and welcome environmental upgrade for our school. The work will be carried out during the day by Brightline Construction. A Project Manager from the School District will be assigned to supervise the contractor to ensure minimal disruption to the school day.
