Criterion Laboratories, Inc. performed Lead Safe Assessment of the paint and plaster damage surfaces in the rooms used for Bright Futures Program in the Ground Floor of the George Washington High School located at 10175 Bustleton Avenue, Philadelphia, PA 19116. The rooms list (which consisted of Classrooms 408, 409, 410, Boys Restroom, Girls Restroom, Kitchen, Main Hallway and the Stairwells at Ground Floor) was confirmed on site with the Building Engineer at the time of the Assessment. The XRF testing of these surfaces indicated that Lead-Based Paint was not detected. The Assessment scope was limited to the Interior, below the suspended ceiling/enclosed ceiling, and Student/Teacher occupied areas that were accessible at the time of the Assessment. The Assessment was performed by EPA certified Lead Risk Assessor, Ananth K. Vinjamuri of Criterion Laboratories, Inc. on August 14, 2019.
