Dear Bluford Charter School and Daroff Charter School Families and Students,

The School District of Philadelphia is inviting all families with students who are currently enrolled in Universal Bluford Charter School (Bluford) and Universal Daroff Charter School (Daroff) to consider enrolling in one of the many District schools that have seats available for the 2022-2023 school year.

At the School Board meeting on August 18, the Board of Education shared that it has serious concerns about the health and safety of students, staff, and families at Bluford and Daroff as we quickly approach the start of the new school year. To date, there are a significant number of staffing vacancies and facilities concerns across both schools that impact the charter schools' ability to provide critical support and services to students and families. As the Board stated, the health and safety of students in Philadelphia is paramount.

The Charter Schools Office and other District staff have been in communication with representatives from Bluford and Daroff to understand and evaluate the circumstances and assess the charter schools' ability to safely open and operate this school year. However, the information to date leaves doubt on whether Bluford and Daroff will be able to operate this coming school year which is only 11 days away. The Board stated last night that it is deeply concerned and would like to ensure Bluford and Daroff families have stable and supportive school options for their children.

The School District wants to assure you that we are ready to welcome your child into a caring, stable and inclusive school environment that will support their educational needs.
