Every parent and guardian will be welcomed and encouraged to be partners in their child's school community.

Guardrail Indicator 3.1:

The percentage of schools with a high Overall District Wide Survey School Relationship rating will grow from 24.2% (52 schools) in August 2020 to 61.9% (133 schools) by August 2026.

Guardrail Indicator 3.2:

The percentage of schools that have a School Advisory Council (SAC) that holds the required minimum number of meetings per year will grow from 89.3% (192 schools) in August 2020 to 100.0% (216 schools) by August 2026.

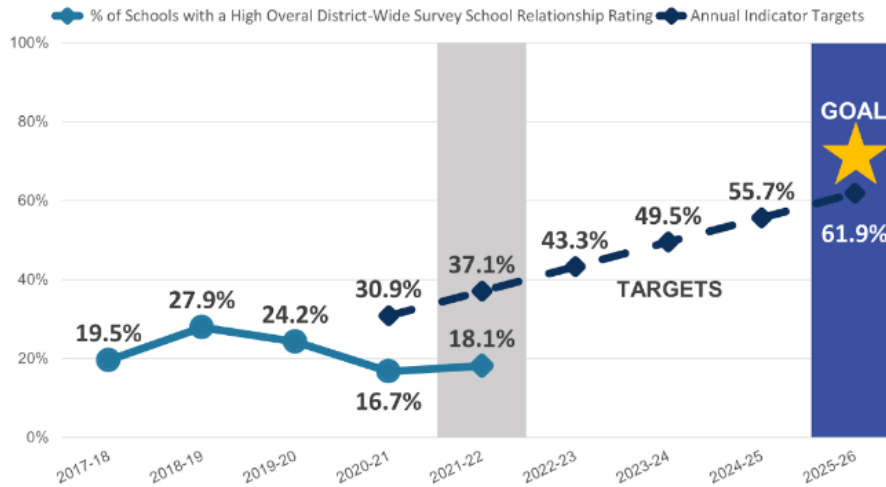

The percentage of schools with a high Relationship Score decreased since 2019-20 and is below the target.

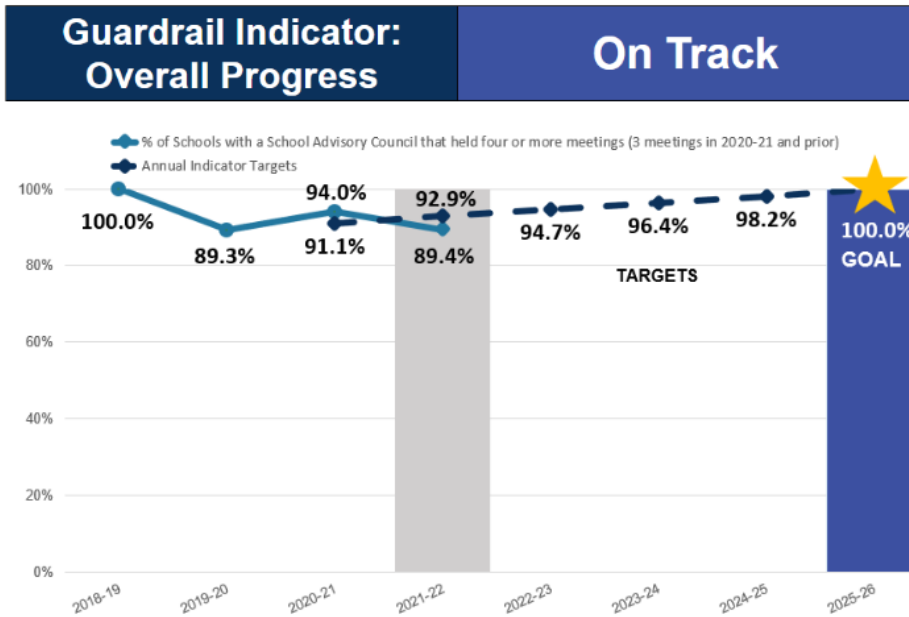
Guardrail Indicator: Overall Progress

Off Track



- Our 2021-22 target for Guardrail Indicator 3.1 was 37.1% of schools will have a high relationship score. We are Off Track on this Indicator.
- Data represents the first year since 2018-19 that students were in schools for a full year.
- Progress is negatively impacted by schools with low or no survey participation. Of the 127 schools with survey results, 31% met Guardrail Indicator 3.1.
- In addition to the 39 schools meeting the goal, 75 schools are within 1 point of meeting the high relationship score.

The percentage of schools with a School Advisory Council (SAC) that meets the required number of times per year decreased from last year and misses the target.



- Our 2021-22 target for Guardrail Indicator 3.2 was 92.9% of schools will have a School Advisory Council (SAC) that meets four or more times a year. We are On Track on this Indicator.
- The required number of meetings changed from 3 or more between 2018-19 and 2020-21 to 4 or more in 2021-22, which accounts for the slight decrease from last year.

A high School Relationship Topic score is considered a school-level School Relationship topic score of 8.0 or higher and includes all accepted responses. For the District Wide Survey Response Rates, Parents/Guardians are counted by household, with a household counted for each school one of the household's student(s) attend.

Starting in 2021-22, the required number of School Advisory Council (SAC) meetings required to meet Guardrail Indicator 3.2 rose from 3 to 4 meetings. This change was made to align to The Office of Family and Community Engagement's requirement that SACs should hold at least four meetings per year.
