# Summer Reading Project 7th/8th Grade ELA

It's really important that you continue to practice your reading, writing, and creativity skills over the summer. This one pager summer reading assignment will help you do all three! <u>Please read all instructions carefully</u>. **This project is due on the first day of school** (August 31st, 2021) and will be graded by your 7th grade ELA teacher.

#### Instructions:

Over the summer you will be expected to read a middle school level book and complete a one pager that demonstrates your understanding of the plot, characters, and other literary elements.

### Materials Needed:

- Blank (not lined!!) white paper
- Chosen Independent Reading Book - you must choose your book from <u>this list</u>
- Colored pencils, markers

#### Directions:

- 1. Choose and obtain a book from THIS LIST.
- Read the book! Pay close attention to the characters, story plot, and theme. \*DO NOT write in the book if you are borrowing it from the library\*
- After you read, use the book to create a one pager that follows the "One Pager Expectations/Rubric." Your one pager should be handwritten, NOT typed or created on a computer.

## **One Pager Expectations/Rubric:** Your one pager MUST have

the following ...

- Complete objective summary of the novel
- Your personal review Would you recommend this book to a friend? Why or why not
- Protagonist name and 5 adjectives to describe them
- One theme that represents the novel
- Title and Author of novel
- Your one pager is visually easy to read and understand
