

## Accountability Policy----THE BOBCHECK

In an effort to improve student accountability and raise the standards of our students to magnet school expectations, the 'Accountability Policy' will be enacted immediately. In order for students to be eligible to participate in any Program related and/or extra-curricular activities (this includes anything that takes place after school such as all academic or non-academic trips, clubs, internships, practices, performances etc.), the student must maintain the academic standards of an FLC student.

Students must have the following in their ongoing academic and social progress:

- Maintain passing grades in ALL rostered courses.

Students who have been deemed as **struggling**, will be **MANDATED** to check in weekly with their program leader, and have with him/her a pass (THE BOBPASS). The program leader and/or teacher designated to that program, will check the student's progress within the week period using infinite campus.

- If the struggling student is missing any assignments for any course, and is deemed as failing that course, he/she has until Monday to make up those assignments to be eligible for at most 80% credit for those specific assignments. The student will be ineligible to participate in activities, until the next Wednesday check in day (one-week period).
- If the struggling student is passing rostered courses, he/she will be deemed eligible to participate for the one-week period and will receive a paw print stamp on their pass, indicating eligibility.
- If the student is rostered to Edgenuity, either for grade improvement or credit recovery, they must check if they are not showing adequate progress.

Using grades from the 2<sup>nd</sup> marking period, Program leaders will be asked to fill out BobPasses for students who failed one or more rostered courses. BobPasses will be distributed to the students through the Dean of Students and the Assistant Principal.
