

Equitable Participation Process Flow: Reevaluation

This workflow details the process by which students parentally placed in nonpublic schools are reevaluated for continued eligibility for special education services under IDEA Equitable Participation. This workflow also includes students previously identified by a non-IU26 entity as eligible for special education services and requires an additional evaluation from IU 26 to continue to receive services.

There are two pathways through which students are identified for reevaluation:

- 1. **Statutory Reevaluation** Reevaluations are required once every 3 years, unless both the parent and IU26 agree to waive the reevaluation. In this instance, the "Agreement to Waive" form should be utilized. Students with an intellectual disability must be reevaluated every 2 years, this reevaluation may not be waived.
- 2. **Parent / Guardian Request for Reevaluation** a parent or guardian may request a reevaluation at any time. A reevaluation may be conducted sooner than the milestones identified above, but no sooner than annually, if the parent / guardian requests the reevaluation.
