TIPS

- Become focused and organized when applying for funding.
- Less expensive projects are more likely to be achievable than more expensive projects. For example: \$500 vs. \$5,000.
- Helps you to decide whether to apply for a grant or start a crowdfunding project
- Redo your priorities list every 6 to 12 months as school and classroom needs change often.

In 6 months, if you were able to get \$500, what would you purchase for your classroom? (List up to 3 items)

In 1 year, if you were able to get \$1,000, what would you purchase for your classroom? (List up to 3 items)

In 2 years, if you were able to get \$2,000, what would you purchase for your classroom? (List up to 3 items)
