

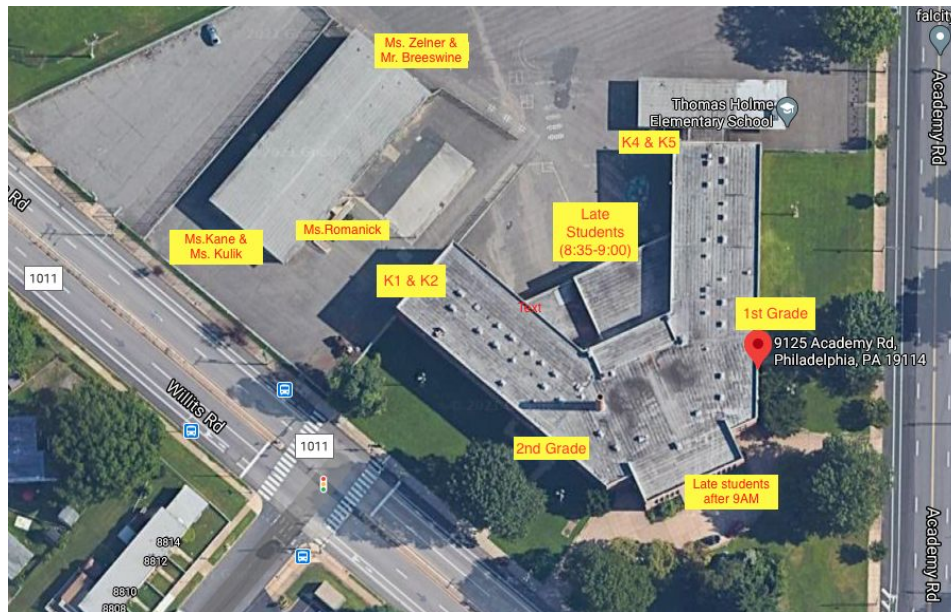
Entering/Exiting Procedures for Hybrid Return to the Building

While there are a variety of emotions swirling around our return to the building for in-person learning we must all push past them to concentrate on making sure we are all following the established safety procedures and protocols. To this end, we will start with how we enter and dismiss from our building.

Let's start from the beginning. Before leaving your home you should complete the COVID pre-screening protocol for each child attending in person learning. **This document will be shared from the School District.** Once you have completed and passed this step you will proceed to Thomas Holme.



1st and 2nd Grade as well as our AS students riding SDOP transportation will enter through the cafeteria doors in a socially distanced manner upon arrival. They will be guided into the building by staff. The Office of Transportation will share your pick-up/drop-off information in a separate communication.

All other students should arrive **no earlier than 8:25AM** at their designated doors. This is crucial to maintain the safety of all students. At 8:25AM staff will open doors to admit students. They will be guided to social distance outside their classrooms by staff inside the building until 8:30AM when their teacher will escort them into the classroom.

Pre-K students will enter through the assigned door as follows:



Mr. Breeswine and Ms. Zelner will use the parking lot entrance. Students will need to maintain social distancing while in the school yard and when entering the building.



Ms. Romanik will use the center Head Start doors. Students will need to maintain social distancing while in the school yard and when entering the building.



Ms. Kulik and Ms. Kane will use the door facing Willits Road. Students will need to maintain social distancing while in the school yard and when entering the building.



Kindergarten students in Rooms 1 and 2 will enter through the Kindergarten door in the yard on the Willits Road side of the building. Students will need to maintain social distancing while in the school yard and when entering the building.



Kindergarten students in Rooms 4 and 5 will enter through the Kindergarten door in the yard on the Academy side of the building. Students will need to maintain social distancing while in the school yard and when entering the building.



First Grade students will enter the building using the entrance on the Academy entrance. They will need to maintain social distancing while entering the building.



Second Grade students will enter the building using the entrance on the Willits Road entrance. They will need to maintain social distancing while entering the building.



Students arriving after 8:35AM will need to enter at the brown gym door where they will be directed by school personnel to their classrooms.

Students arriving after 9:00AM will enter through the main entrance. They will be allowed to enter one at a time so that social distancing can be maintained.

Dismissal:

All students will be dismissed into the school yard.
