Dear Hopkinson Families of Students in Grades K through 2,

As communicated yesterday, a temporary relocation plan is being activated while air quality testing continues at Hopkinson. **Students and staff in grades K through 2 will remain at the Little School House and modular on the Hopkinson campus and school will resume on Wednesday, February 5.** Your child's teachers and support staff will remain at the Little School House to maintain the same instructional quality and school supports.

As a reminder, Wednesday through Friday, February 5-7, are previously-scheduled half days for students. Breakfast and lunch will still be served to students. School will dismiss at noon and we ask that families make arrangements for children to be safely picked up at this time. Report Card Conferences will be held at Hopkinson School's Little School House from 1:30-3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

There was no single relocation site nearby that was large enough to house the entire Hopkinson School. Therefore, students and staff in grades 6 through 8, including the AS Class, will relocate to unused classroom space at Grover Washington Middle School (201 E. Olney Ave.). Grades 3 through 5 will relocate to unused classroom space at Clemente Middle School (122 W Erie Ave.). They will remain at their temporary sites until Hopkinson air quality tests are completed, results are assessed and next steps are determined. We will update you as soon as all testing results are available.

We are excited to welcome students to school on Wednesday, Feb. 5. Please call the Hopkinson office line at 215-400-3970 from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. with any questions. Thank you for your patience and support as we resume teaching and learning for our students.
