## Virtual Learning during COVID-19:

As of now, the district is planning for a hybrid learning experience. Half of the students will attend school in person on Mondays and Wednesdays and the other half will attend on Tuesdays/Thursdays. All students will learn virtually from home on Fridays. Please monitor the school district website for updates/changes regarding the 2020/2021 school year.

If classes resume virtually in the fall, please check to make sure that your child is turning in assignments. If classes resume in-person in the fall, please check your child's homework. Homework will be assigned Monday through Friday. It is important for students to complete daily homework assignments as they provide students with an opportunity to review and practice skills covered in school each day.

Please monitor your child's daily reading habits, as independent reading outside of school will be critical to strengthening his/her fluency and comprehension skills. He/She should read a book of his/her choice each day for at least 30 minutes.

### READING LOGS (during in person learning)

Students are required to read 30 minutes each night in conjunction with their daily reading homework. Students may choose a book from the public library, our classroom library, or from any other additional sources. This book will serve as their independent reading book in school as well, so it is important that the students bring their book to school on a daily

basis. A reading log will be provided to the students to keep track of their reading and for a parent signature each night. Furthermore, the students will be required to turn in a book report at the end of each month (Starting in October) on a book of their choice. The book report form will be provided by the teacher. Happy reading!

### ATTENDANCE/UNIFORMS

If for some reason your child is absent, a written note must be brought back the day your child returns to school in order for the absence to be excused, a Dojo message will not be accepted. We have several amazing incentives going on this year so you will want to make sure that your children are here and on time ③. Also, students must be in uniform everyday.

#### CLASS DOJO

We will be using Class Dojo this year for parent/teacher communication, monitoring behavior, and classroom rewards and incentives.
