We are already gearing up for an incredible new school year. Our teachers have attended training sessions to better help all students learn and grow. Our front office team is updating student files and ordering new materials. Our hard-working custodians have spent the summer cleaning our school. And, our cafeteria workers are preparing to serve your children delicious, healthy and <u>free</u> breakfast and lunch each school day.

All 6<sup>th</sup> grade classrooms will be receiving new tables and chairs to enhance the learning environment for our middle school students.
