- ❖ The first day of school for students is Tuesday, August 31; the school day begins at 8:20am.
- ❖ All students, K-8 will attend 5 full days of school, in-person.
- Uniforms will be required again next year; royal blue collared shirt with black bottoms.

Students will continue to be assigned 1:1 Chromebooks next year. If they did not receive a device or it is in need of repair, it should be taken care of this summer. Students who are graduating 8th grade and going to high school will take their Chromebook with them. Incoming kindergarten students will receive notification this summer about obtaining a new Chromebook.
