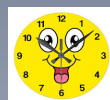
Saturday March 3rd- Pancake Breakfast at Applebee's to support the cost of producing the Lion King Play.

- A few reminders about colder weather. On days when it rains, snows, or the temperature is below 32 degrees, students can enter the building at 8:05 AM. Grades 3-5 enter via door 5 and grades K-2 enter via door 4 into the cafeteria.
