- KG 45.9%

- 2<sup>nd</sup> grade 53.1%
- 3<sup>rd</sup> grade 64.9%
- 4<sup>th</sup> grade 66.9%
- 5<sup>th</sup> grade 62%

You play the most important role in making sure your child is here on time. We want them to learn and they can't do that if they miss days here and there. Please bring your child to school every day. on

## **Important Reminders**

- The last day of school is June 4<sup>th</sup>. Please do not plan to leave before June 4<sup>th</sup> as you will not receive a report card. It is important for children to be in school until the last day.
