

Immunization Requirements

IS YOUR STUDENT READY FOR 12TH GRADE?

DID YOU KNOW...

...the Pennsylvania Department of Health requires all students entering 12th grade to submit the required proof of vaccinations prior to school attendance or they will not be able to attend school? It's the law.



Follow these steps to make sure your student is ready for school.



SCHEDULE

your student's well visit to ensure receipt of the required 12th grade vaccinations:

- Meningococcal Conjugate (MCV4)— 2 doses*

*The second MCV4 dose is not needed if the first MCV4 dose was given after the student's 16th birthday



OBTAIN

a medical certificate signed by your student's doctor, detailing the plan to complete vaccines on the appropriate schedule.

SUBMIT

an exemption form if your student is exempt from any immunizations for a medical, religious or philosophical/ strong moral reason.

Exempt students may be removed from school during a disease outbreak.
