

Creating and Saving Scratch Art

Open scratch.mit.edu and click Create.

Copy the script to the right.. Change the numbers around in the script to make a different, interesting work of patterned art. When you have created a pattern that you want to turn in:

1. Hold the Control key and click the picture with your mouse.
2. Let go of the Control key and click :Save Picture of stage."
3. Save it with your name and add .png to the end. **Make sure it is saved to the desktop.**
4. **Go to Google Classroom.** Make sure you are signed in under you account.
5. Click "Scratch Art
6. Click "Add", Choose "From File."
7. Find your file. Click "Choose"
8. Click "Upload."
9. Click "Turn in."

You're done!
