

- I. Students must be identified in 'School Uniform'.
 - a. The term 'School Uniform' refers to the color of the following articles of clothing:
 - i. Polo Shirts / Solid Pattern T-Shirts
 - ii. Dress Pants / Sweat Pants
 - iii. Jumpers / Skirts
 - iv. Leggings / Tights
 - v. Official Mitchell School Apparel

- II. Students must be identified in 'School Colors'
 - a. The term 'School Colors' refers to the following colors and standards:
 - i. Navy
 - ii. Light Blue
 - iii. White
 - iv. Tan / Khaki
 - v. Official Mitchell School Apparel

- III. Students are permitted to wear 'outerwear' on their person.
 - a. The term 'outerwear' refers to the following articles of clothing:
 - i. Sweatshirts
 - ii. Hooded Sweatshirts
 - iii. Sweaters
 - iv. Sweatshirts

- IV. School District Code of Conduct States:
 - a. No student, at anytime, shall be identified wearing a hood while on school grounds.

- V. The following process will be implemented to document and intervene w uniform violations:
