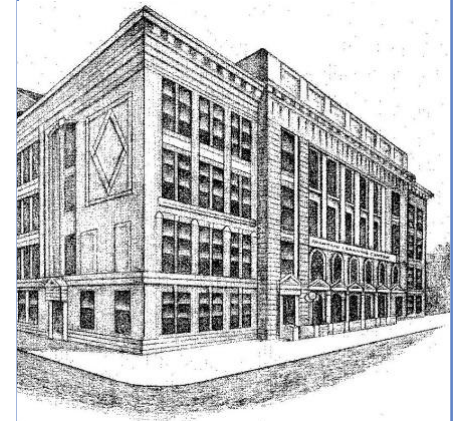

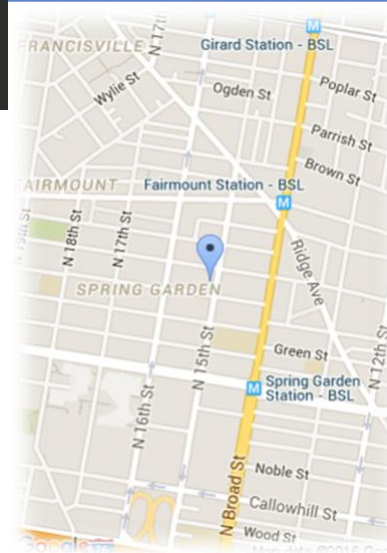

The Newcomer Learning Academy (NLA) is for students who are: (1) 14 – 20 years of age, (2) recent arrivals to the United States (less than one year in U.S. school), and (3) speak a first language other than English.

Students are enrolled through the Multilingual Assessment Center (MAC): 215-400-4240 (Option 1). If a student has a high school transcript, it may be given to the FLC Roster Office or to the MAC.

School District of Philadelphia graduation requirements are 23.5 credits: English (4), History/Social Science (4), Math (3-4), Science (3-4), humanities (2), electives (4), physical education (1) health (.5), & a world language (2).

Attendance is very important. If you are absent from school, you need a note (letter) signed by your parent / guardian. If you are absent 3+ days, you need a note from a doctor. An “excused” absence is for illness, death in the family, a school trip, or a religious holiday. If you have questions, please talk to your Advisory teacher.

If you have an “early dismissal,” (leave early) you

need a note from your parent/ guardian. If you are not 18 years of age, your parent / guardian must pick you up. They must have a photo ID.

When you are sick, please tell your teacher. If you take medication, you must give the medication to the nurse in Room 111.

The NLA has 9 teachers, and Bilingual Counseling Assistants (BCA). A FLC school counselor will help with college and career planning and social / emotional support. The BCA will help with translation, social services and community supports.

Consequences for negative behavior include “detention.” Detention is an additional or extra hour after school for students who:

- are late to school or class,
- “cut” class (do not go to class), &/or
- participate in negative (bad) behavior in class, school hallways, the lunchroom, on school trips, going and coming to school, etc.
