Mr. Moore has served as the Climate Manager of the Honorable Luis Muñoz-Marín Elementary School since 2016. Working with the leadership team, instructional staff, and climate support personnel, Muñoz-Marín’s system of positive behavioral support and high student expectations has been implemented and facilitated with model success. Since 2016, the number of students with no out-of-school suspensions has increased almost 9%, daily attendance has increased, and the Serious Incident Rate has decreased. Muñoz-Marín has received the Accelerated Improvement Award for both of the past 2 years and the Exemplary 3 Consecutive Years of SPR growth award last year.

Mr. Moore has been an educator and coach since beginning his career at Glen Mills Schools in 1996. Prior to becoming a Climate Manager, Mr. Moore served as a dean of students, coach, and middle and high school teacher. Mr. Moore was born and raised in Williamsport, PA and has tirelessly advocated for student and animal rights through his varied experiences in schools in addition to service in Little League Baseball, the Philadelphia Zoo, and with his own 2 school-age children.
