WHAT DOES THE DISTRICT'S WELLNESS POLICY SAY?

SDP Policy 145: All foods sold on school campus must meet the *USDA's Smart Snacks* in School Nutrition Standards for Food. These foods may be sold for fundraising purposes on the school campus during the school day without a limit on frequency.

YOUR SNACK DOESN'T QUALIFY? IT'S OKAY...

Foods that do **not** meet the Smart Snack standards can still be sold, but are limited to:

Elementary and
Middle Schools



No more than **5**
unqualified fundraiser
s each year

High Schools



No more than **10**
unqualified fundraisers
each year

Each fundraiser may not exceed one (1) school week.

RAFFLES

Sell raffle tickets and add some fun to Back to School Night and Report Card Conferences

SUPERFIT SCHOOL CHALLENGE

Action for Healthy Kids will supply materials for a 5-station obstacle course that combines healthy eating with physical activity

DRESS DOWN DAY

Have staff and students wear non uniform clothes - get creative!

HEALTHY SNACKS

Find pre-approved healthy snacks to sell on the Healthier Generation Store on Amazon.com

CLASSROOM PENNY DRIVE

The classroom that collects the most pennies wins a reward!

TEACHER-STUDENT SPORTS GAME

Students play against their teachers in a sports game such as basketball or soccer. Charge a fee to register.

THONS

Host a -thon at the school and charge a fee to participate or have students collect pledges from friends and family! (e.g., dance, bike, color run, or a walkathon)

Ask a healthy restaurant or bookstore to donate proceeds back to the school or host a movie and popcorn sale at the school.

DUCT TAPE

Pick a teacher/principal to tape to the wall. Charge per piece of tape.
