- Assessment Calendar: Updated (12.7.20) the Assessment Calendar, includes Star, aimswebPlus, & PASA testing windows for the rest of the year. The second testing window for aimswebPLUS & Star opens on December 14, 2020, and closes January 29, 2021. As with the Fall window, both tests will be administered remotely, so long as instruction remains virtual.https://www.philasd.org/era/assessment/calendar/
- ★ The 2021 PASA testing window has been changed to March 8, 2021- May 7, 2021.
 - Parents/Guardians who do not yet have a Parent & Family Portal can register for one by visiting the <u>Office of Family and Community Engagement's Parent & Family Portal website</u>.
