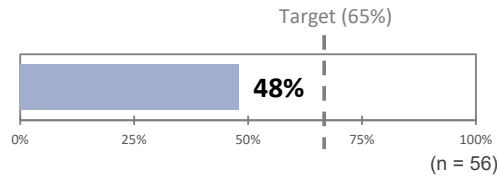

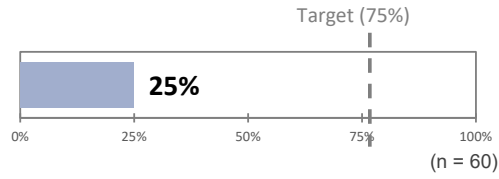

Distribution by Attendance Band

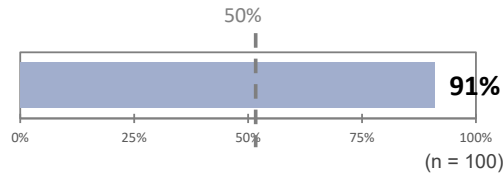

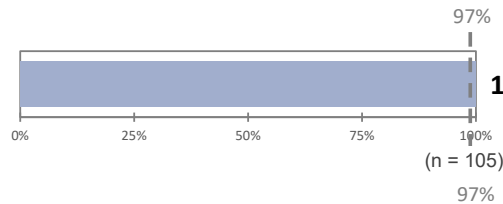

Student Survey: Climate³ Percent of Most Positive Responses

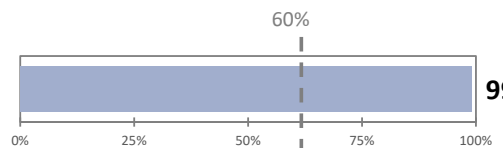

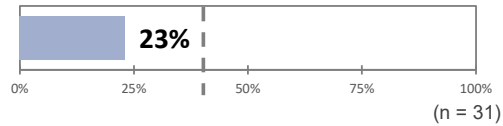

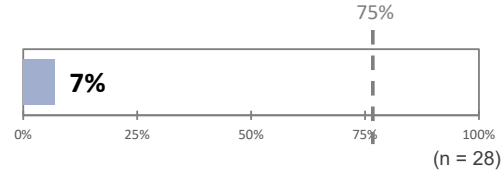
