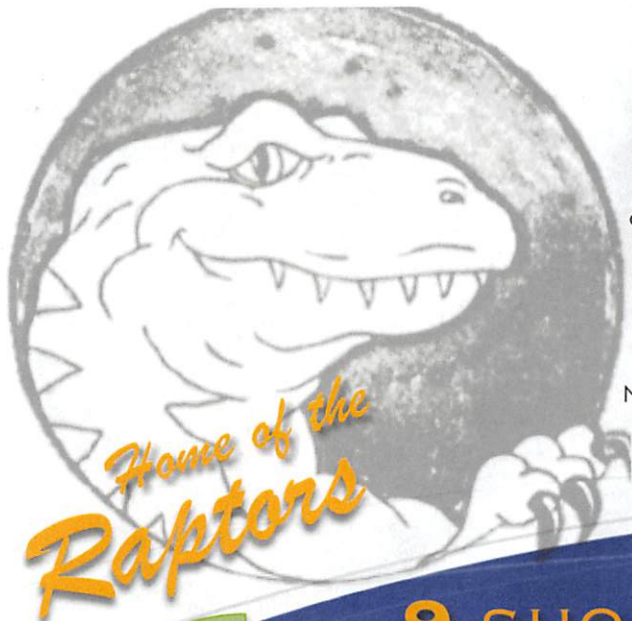
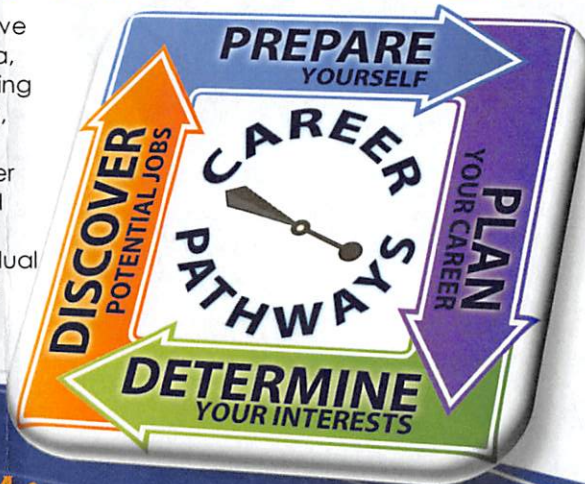


FIND YOUR FUTURE HERE...

In addition to selecting a CTE Program, Randolph students have an opportunity to explore electives such as visual arts, drama, and foreign language. They can also participate in the following sports: baseball, basketball, football, bowling, cheerleading, softball, and track & field. Career and Technical Student Organizations (CTSO) such as HOSA, DECA, and SkillsUSA offer students the chance to compete on the state and national levels. Students also have the opportunity to qualify for the National Honor Society and earn college credits through the dual enrollment agreement with Philadelphia University and the Community College of Philadelphia.



9 SHOPS TO CHOOSE FROM:

HEALTH RELATED TECHNOLOGY



Prepares students for various careers within the medical field including nursing, nursing assistant, and home health care aid.

COLLISION REPAIR TECHNOLOGY



Prepares students for a career as a collision repair technician through instruction in cost estimating, painting & refinishing, metal straightening and body construction.

AUTOMOTIVE MECHANICS



Prepares students for a career in servicing all automobile systems including engine performance, electrical, steering and suspension, brakes and vehicle maintenance.

VENDING TECHNOLOGY



Prepares students for a career in the vending industry through instruction in electronics, robotics, telemetry, and refrigeration theory.

FIRE ACADEMY



Prepares students for a career as an Emergency Medical Technician or Firefighter. Students will be CPR certified and may earn EMT certification.

WELDING TECHNOLOGY



Prepares students to perfect both small and large scale welding techniques that are used in almost forms of construction.

DENTAL ASSISTING



Prepares students for a career as a dental assistant. Students may earn a PA Dental X-ray license and pursue post-secondary education in EFDA, Dental Hygiene, and/or dental school.

CONSTRUCTION TECHNOLOGY



Prepares students for all phases of house building, including carpentry, electrical, plumbing, & architecture.

CULINARY ARTS



Prepares students for careers in all aspects of the food and restaurant industries.

Students must obtain 26.5 credits in order to graduate from a career & technical education high school.
