2. The Philadelphia School District's Parent & Guardian Survey will be available via philasd.org/parentsurvey and in the Parent Portal from January 28, 2019 to June 7, 2019.
3. **You will need your child's School District of Philadelphia Student ID number to take the survey.** If your student goes to a district school, you can find this number on your child's report card. If your student goes to a charter school, contact your school to obtain your student's District ID. If you cannot locate this number, please contact your child's school.
4. The survey will be available online in 9 languages.
5. You are encouraged to take one survey for each of your children.
6. The survey is confidential. Your answers will be combined with answers from other parents and guardians.
