Survey Implementation


- The CTE office provided the Office of Research and Evaluation (ORE) with a list of recent graduates that included 1,307 CTE students.
- This list was cross-referenced with students that completed SDP's Senior Exit Survey the previous year.
 - At least one form of contact information (email address/cell phone number) was available for 937 of the 1,307 CTE students (71.7%) as they responded and provided the information on the 2017-18 Senior Exit Survey
- The survey was then distributed electronically to the 917 email addresses and 857 phone numbers. Students who provided both an email address and a cell phone number (n=841) were alerted by both methods.
 - Email/text survey alerts were sent out on April 26, June 7, and July 19, 2019. The survey closed on August 31, 2019.
 - Students' survey completion was monitored throughout the survey period and at the time of each alert only students who had not yet completed the survey were prompted to respond.

Survey Response Rates

- 277 of 937 CTE students who received the survey provided a valid response
- Final response rate: 29.5%*
- Most survey responses were received on the days a survey alert was sent out (April 26, June 7, and July 19)

*This is the final response rate (text and email invitation) after data cleaning for duplicate submissions, invalid records and incomplete surveys.


Distribution Channel Email SMS Invite


Education

As of October, November, and/or December of 2018 were you enrolled in school? (n=277)




Academic program of students enrolled in school

Job status of students in school


In addition to school, which option best describes your job status? (n=185)

Job status of students NOT in school


Were you employed as of October, November, and/or December of 2017? (n=92)
