### 1. Do principals set high standards for student learning?


We asked teachers and parents/guardians...

"The principal [or school leader] sets high standards for student learning." How much do you agree or disagree?

> Teacher survey item: How much do you agree or disagree? "The principal sets high standards for student learning." Parent survey item: "The principal or school leader has high standards for student learning." Results are based on responses from 6,663 teachers and 35,020 parents and guardians.

#### The survey said...

Teachers generally agreed with parents and guardians: 89% of teachers and 94% of parents agreed or strongly agreed that their school principal sets high standards for student learning, and only 3% of respondents from both groups strongly disagreed.


#### 2. Do principals communicate a clear mission or vision?

#### "The principal [or school leader] has a clear mission for the school." How much do you agree or disagree?




#### 3. Do principals promote community involvement?

The survey said...

Compared to teachers, a higher percentage of parents and guardians *agreed* or *strongly agreed* that their principal promotes family engagement (92% vs. 86%). Only 8% of parents *disagreed* or *strongly disagreed* with this statement, compared to 14% of teachers.
