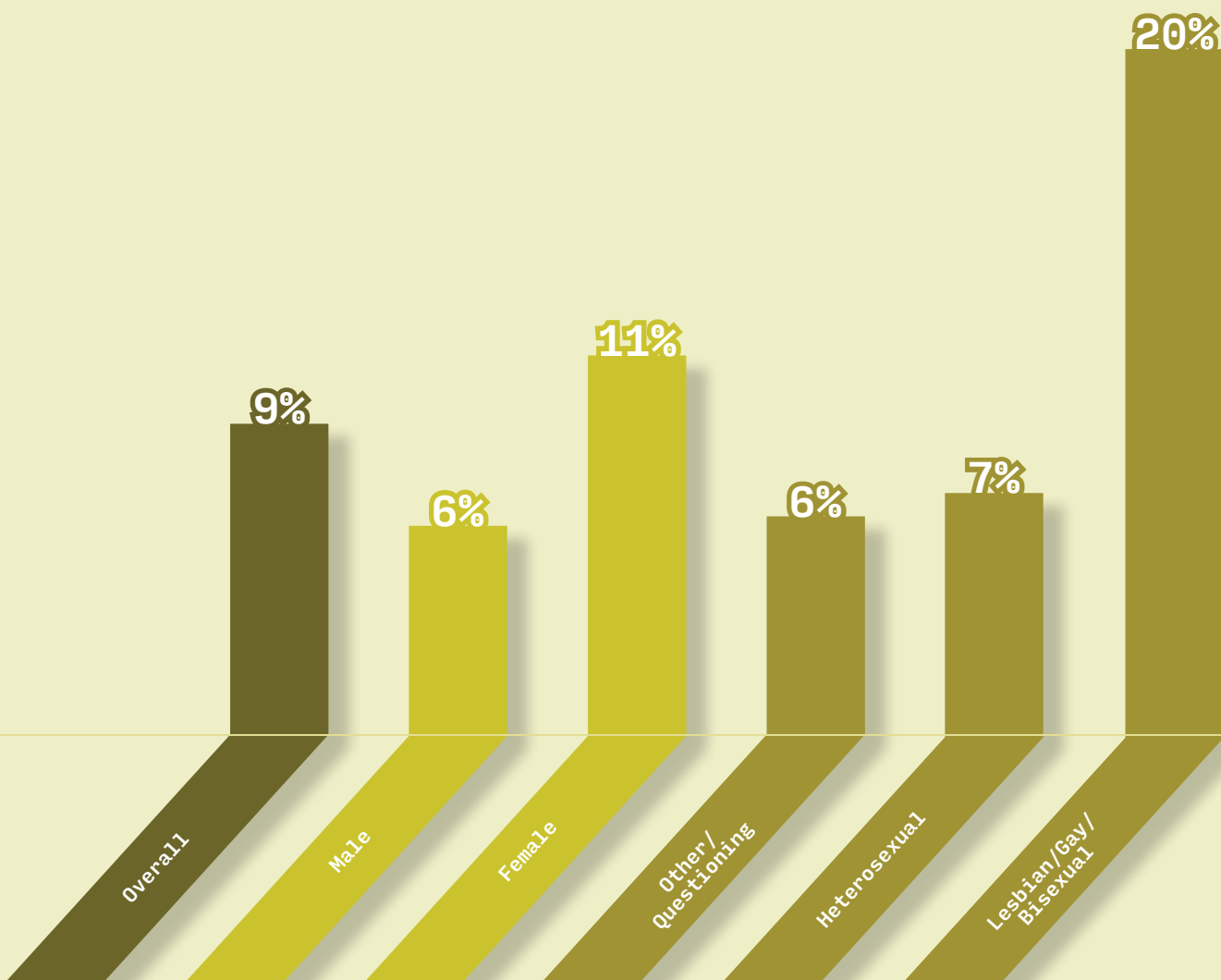

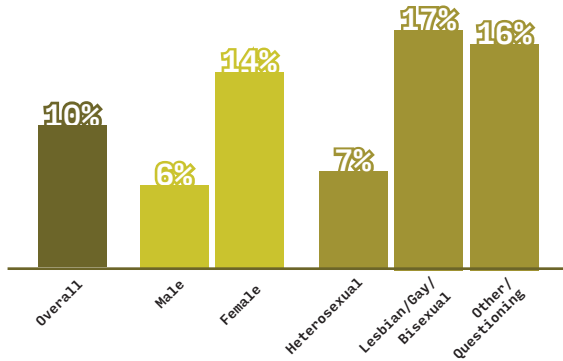

Percentage of high school students who were ever physically forced to have sexual intercourse when they did NOT want to.

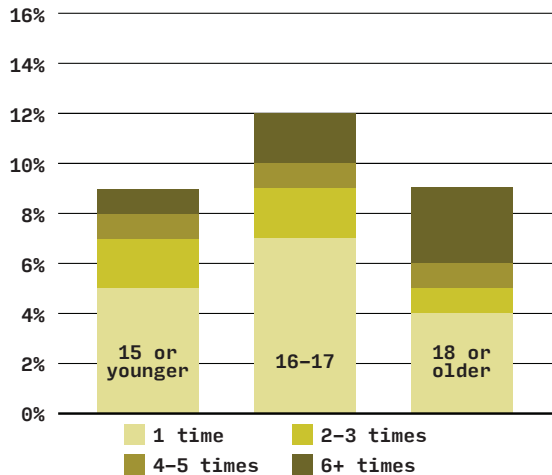


Sexual Violence

Percentage of high school students who experienced sexual violence

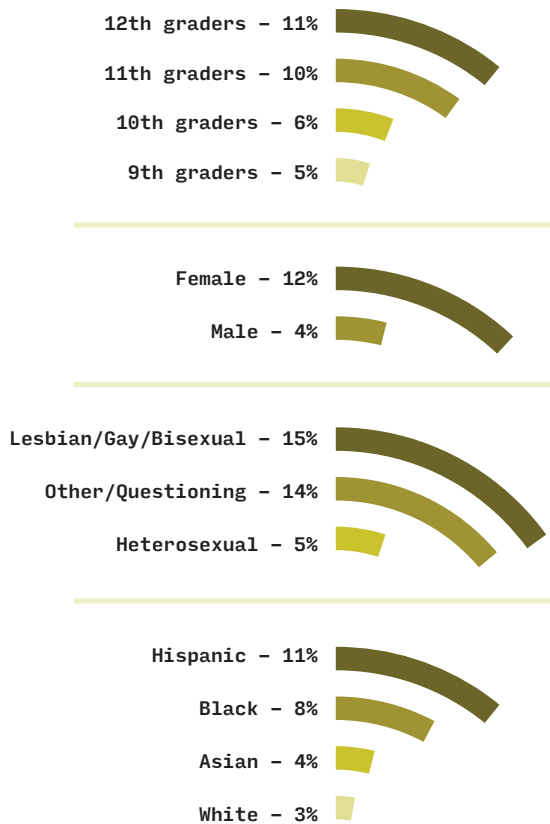


During the past 12 months, how many times did anyone force you to do sexual things that you did not want to do?
