

Key Terms

District schools

Schools that are operated by the School District of Philadelphia

Charter schools

Schools that are operated by external providers authorized by the Board of Education

Alternative education programs

Programs that serve students who are not succeeding in the traditional school sector (typically students who are overage and undercredited), run by the District or by an external provider

Goals & Guardrails

Key indicators of student achievement and school climate, established and monitored by the Board of Education


Accountability Report

Report measuring performance on the Goals & Guardrails

Accountability reports are part of an improvement cycle

District-Level Progress Review

Regular checkpoints during the year to monitor District progress toward the Goals & Guardrails and to consider improvement strategies



School Progress Report on Education and Equity (SPREE)

Annual summary of each school's progress toward the Goals & Guardrails and other key conditions for success


School-Level Progress Review

Regular checkpoints during the year to monitor each school's improvement and progress toward their goals

School Improvement Plan

Uses SPREE results to set goals and identify school-level strategies to support improvement

History of Accountability Reports in SDP



What is the AEPR?

The Alternative Education Progress Report (AEPR) is the District's accountability report for alternative education program performance.

- Released each year for the previous school year for most alternative education programs
- Aligned to metrics and expectations outlined in the program contracts
- Supports Opportunity Network's program expansion/closure decisions (in conjunction with operational & instructional walkthroughs)

What is the SPREE?

The School Progress Report on Education and Equity (SPREE) is the District's full accountability report for traditional District and charter schools to summarize school performance and progress.

- Closely aligned to the Board of Education's Goals and Guardrails and Conditions for Success, but includes additional metrics
- Released each year for the previous school year

The SPREE explicitly incorporates **equity** through:

Measures of access and opportunity

Many metrics broken out for student groups served

Scoring based on performance for all students and for each student group within a school

What is the SPOTlight?

The School Performance Outcomes
Table (SPOTlight) is an at-a-glance
summary of schoolwide performance
and progress on key measures.

- A one-page overview of overall school performance and improvement on the Board of Education's Goals and Guardrails and the Conditions for Success
- Released each year for the previous school year
- Shows current performance and progress over time






Conditions for Success: Graduation Rate, SY2023-24

Graduation Rate Over Time, Districtwide






Conditions for Success: Student Attendance, SY2023-24

Student Attendance Over Time, Districtwide






Goal 5: Grade 12 CTE Students' Proficiency, SY2023-24




Conditions for Success: Teacher Attendance, SY2023-24

Teacher Attendance Over Time, Districtwide






Conditions for Success: Student Dropouts, SY2023-24

Student Dropouts Over Time, Districtwide






Goal 1: Grades 3-8 ELA Proficiency, SY2023-24

% of Students Proficient or Advanced, Grades 3-8 ELA







% of Students Proficient or Advanced, Grade 3 ELA






Goal 3: Grade 3-8 Math Proficiency, SY2023-24

% of Students Proficient or Advanced, Grades 3-8 Math






Goal 4a: Grade 11 Literature Proficiency, SY2023-24

% of Students Proficient or Advanced, Grade 11 Keystone Literature






Goal 4b: Grade 11 Algebra I Proficiency, SY2023-24

% of Students Proficient or Advanced, Grade 11 Algebra I




