
Did you know?

Why It Matters

Who Is Affected

Kindergarteners through 3rd grade classes often have absenteeism rates as high as those in high school. Many of these absences are excused, but they still add up to lost time in the classroom.

Your child should miss no more than 9 days of school each year to stay engaged, successful, and on track for promotion to the next grade.
