Authority<br>HRC 12-305 | The School Reform Commission (SRC) shall levy taxes annually within such limits<br>and upon such subjects as the General Assembly of the Commonwealth or the<br>Council of the City may from time to time prescribe, in amounts sufficient to<br>provide funds for the current operation of the schools of the district, the payment of<br>interest and sinking fund charges on or other amortization of the debt of the district<br>and its predecessor districts, and to provide for any services which may be incidental<br>to the operation of the schools. Provided, that if the rate of taxation shall be fixed at<br>a mill rate, it shall also be stated in dollars and cents on each one hundred dollars of<br>assessed valuation.<br>When any levy of school taxes has been made by the SRC, the SRC shall forthwith<br>certify the levy, under the seal of the district attested by the Chairperson and<br>Secretary of the SRC, to the proper authority of the City of Philadelphia authorized<br>to prepare tax duplicates, to be entered thereon, and by such authority to be properly<br>certified to the City's Department of Revenue. |
