230 Public Performances by Students

Purpose

The Board of Education (“Board”) recognizes the value of students sharing their talents and skills with the community through student participation and performances in events. This policy sets forth the parameters for public performances by students.

Authority

The Board endorses public performances by students when:

1. they constitute a learning experience which contributes to the educational program; and
2. the circumstances of the event do not pose a threat to the health, safety or wellbeing of the students who are involved.[1]

Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent or designee shall develop administrative regulations to implement this policy.
