

## Office of Teaching and Learning Tune Up Tuesday Professional Development

Tune Up Tuesdays are a professional development opportunity open to all K-12 teachers. These sessions take place twice a month at two different locations to make it accessible for teachers throughout the city to attend. Tune Up Tuesday provides teachers with a menu of options, allowing them to self-select into the session that is most relevant to their growth. The content will remain the same at each location and is grounded in research and student-impact. The majority of time is spent on practice and application of a targeted skill or strategy (no more than two) to ensure that teachers leave confident in their ability implement within the next week.

The focus for Tune Up Tuesdays in 2017-2018 will be classroom management/student behavior, technology integration using Google Apps for Education (G Suite), effective core writing instruction, arts education, family and community engagement, and math instructional content. This work is in partnership with the Office of Educational Technology, the Office of Climate and Safety, Office of Prevention and Intervention, Office of Specialized Services, Office of Family and Community Engagement, and Office of Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment to deliver this content.



Participants have the option to attend a session at one or both locations.

Sessions begin at 4:30pm and end at 6:30pm.

## **Impact**



Each session will have 25 seats available. With 10 sessions offered simultaneously; allowing for 250 teachers per location to receive intensive professional development. Sessions provide multiple opportunities for teachers to practice and apply the content to their work with students.

## **Expectations**



Participants are expected to bring a fully charged laptop and relevant planning materials to each session. Teachers should be ready to actively engage in sessions through structured practice and should be open to receiving feedback from colleagues and facilitators.

## **Registration & Advertisement**

Workshops will be advertised on SchoolNet, the Teacher Information Board and through teacher e-mail distribution lists. Principals may also recommend teachers whom they believe would benefit from the content. Teachers are compensated for the time spent in sessions and will receive two Act 48 hours.
