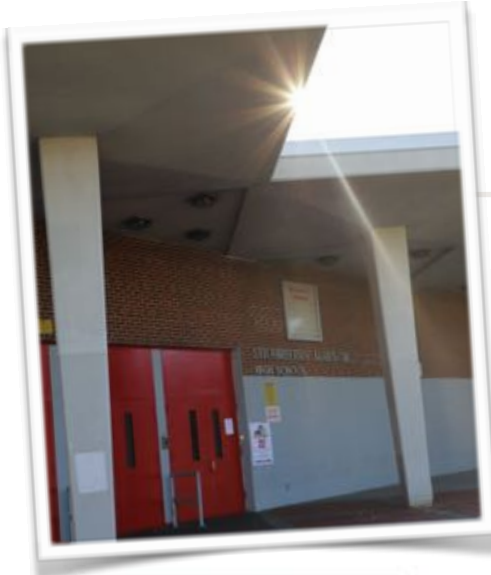

2. Go to the Message Center in the menu.
3. Click on the Google Classroom box.
4. Navigate to the correct Classroom for the class.
5. Click on the Google Meet link in the header.
6. Click "join meeting" promptly at the start time.

When entering into your Google Meet:

- Be on time.
- Find a quiet, distraction free space.
- Sound muted/off, but video on.
- Computers charged and materials ready.
- Dress in appropriate attire.
- Scholars will participate in both synchronous and asynchronous learning.

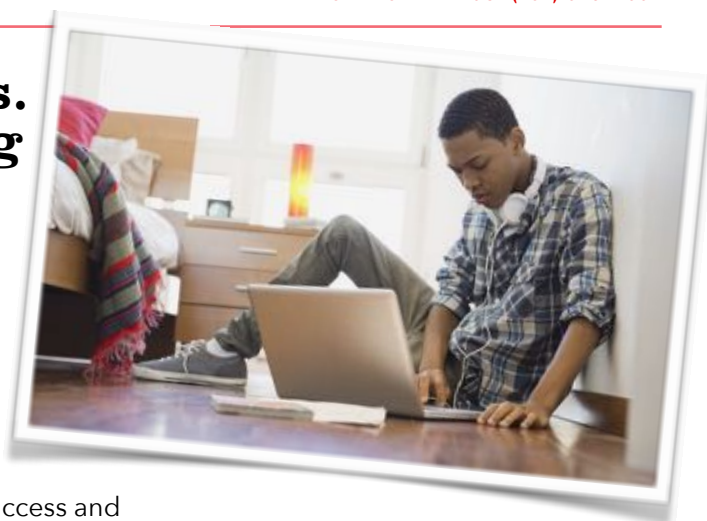

Aynchronous vs. Synchronous Learning

Synchronous learning is the kind of learning that happens in real time. This means that you, your classmates, and your instructor interact in a specific virtual place, through a specific online medium, at a specific time. Methods of synchronous online learning: video conferencing, teleconferencing, live chatting or live-streaming instruction. **Asynchronous** learning happens on your schedule. Your teacher will provide materials for reading, lectures for viewing, assignments for completing, and exams for evaluation. You have the ability to access and satisfy these requirements within a flexible time frame. Methods of asynchronous online learning: self-guided lesson modules, streaming video content, virtual libraries, posted lecture notes and exchanges across various social media platforms. Remote instruction here at The Mansion will be a hybrid of both types of styles of learning, and is slated until November 17th, 2020.

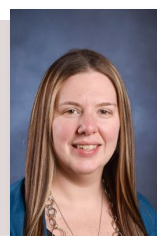
