A blouse or a shirt, or a sweater.


We are only going to see your head and shoulders and part of your neck.

What to expect

10 - 15 head and shoulder cap and gown portraits

2- 4 full length shots of you on a second background. This is being used to make the class picture.

2 - 4 head and shoulder pics without your cap and gown (for other parts of the yearbook and graduation.)

A mask shot before you leave.

When will I see them?

Within a week after the session you will get your numbered proof set in your STUDENT EMAIL account.

Bring your parent's email address!

We want to send the proofs your parents so they can buy a package.

Our packages are inexpensive.

We do not charge a sitting fee!

Portrait packages are **NOT** part of senior dues.

The portrait session is free.

Your picture in the yearbook is free.

What if I hate them?

You won't.

There are no retakes. (Sorry - no time for that with Covid.)

I never smile...

Don't worry about that. You don't have to smile to look good.

You should still try to smile. Even if you hate your smile.

You can always reject it later.

Which one goes in the yearbook?

The one you chose and tell us to use in the Bio Page.

If you don't chose one we will use our best judgement.

I do not take good pictures

Actually, you do. Look through your phone. You will find a few.

It all depends on your attitude and your expression. Just come in and RELAX.

Leave the lights, camera, and posing to me. I will make you look great.

We have Photoshop. (I can make you look great in a picture.)

PS: Your proofs are NOT photoshoped. Only the pictures you pick get photoshoped.
