The Student Transition Center is a one-stop welcome center for all youth that are transitioning back to the School District of Philadelphia and are involved with:

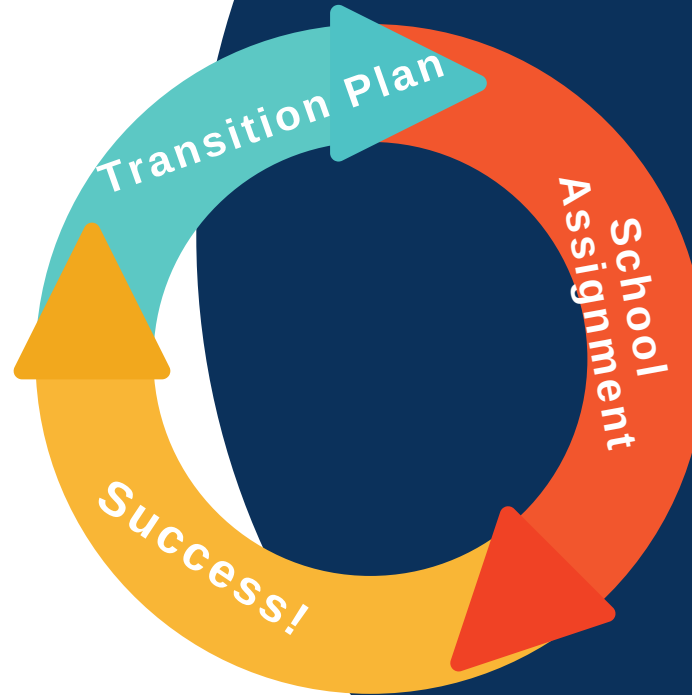
- Juvenile Justice System

The purpose of the Student Transition Center is to collaboratively explore educational options for youth and to assign them to schools that best fit their needs as well as connect them with supports and resources that will help them achieve their academic, social, and career goals.

PROCESS



- family arrives and completes initial in-take.
- student's records gathered
- clinical assessment completed
- collaboration with partners: DHS, CBH, JJS
- student's earned credits evaluated
- transition plan created with identified supports
- school assignment made
- provide family and school assignment notification
- case management services

All students coming through the Student Transition Center should be assigned to a school within 72 hours of the initial intake.

Please note that some placements may require additional time.
