

CONTEXT:

An investment in high quality, ongoing professional learning for teachers and school leaders is essential to student success. The timing, duration, and subject matter of the professional development (PD), outlined here, are intentionally designed to maximize impact on the quality of teaching and learning in our classrooms. By engaging teachers and school leaders in rigorous, relevant professional learning, we ensure continued progress toward meeting the District's Anchor Goals.

PROCESS:

Pull out sessions (required and optional) will be offered for various target audiences on the District-wide PD days. Participants will need to register on Cornerstone for these sessions.

SUPERSITES STRUCTURE:

There are many instances when large groups of teachers across the District need to participate in professional development at the same time on District-wide PD days. Such an undertaking requires a large number of facilitators who are knowledgeable about the content and skilled in facilitating adult learning. In an effort to maximize our efficiency and provide opportunities for teachers to collaborate with colleagues in other schools, SuperSites have been identified within each network where professional development can be held for large clusters of teachers. This model will enable the District to develop more teachers in fewer sites than would otherwise be possible. Staff who need to travel from their school to a SuperSite or vice versa will be afforded travel time in addition to lunch and prep.

SuperSite assignments by school for the various groups of teachers will be shared in the beginning of August 2019.



District-wide Professional Development for Teachers

NOTE: Kindergarten teachers will be conducting family interviews and will not be available for professional development on August 26-29th. Kindergarten teachers must be provided with the contractual reorganization day on August 30th. Kindergarten teachers may elect to work one additional meeting-free interview day to be scheduled prior to August 26, which is subject to approval by the principal. Kindergarten teachers will receive their daily rate of pay for this day.
