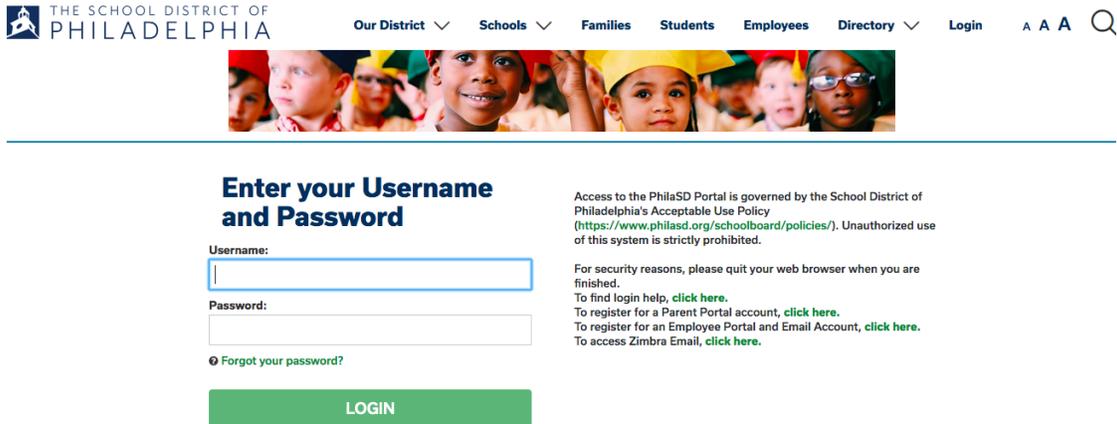


How to log into GOOGLE CLASSROOM

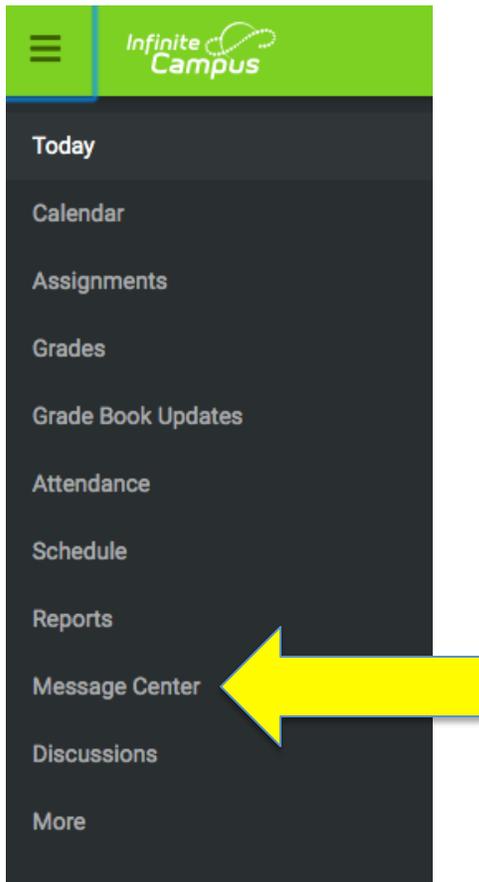
